In May 2020 Willings supplied and installed THREE EvolveFace 5T temperature checking terminals with face recognition for Langdowns DFK three offices in Andover, Basingstoke, and Chandlers Ford.



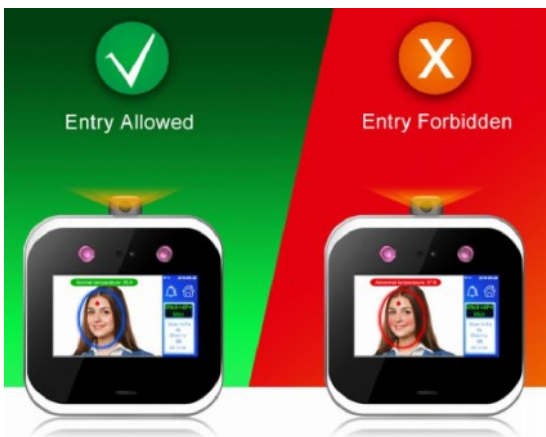
Background

Langdowns DFK are a local well-established firm of accountants with offices in Andover, Basingstoke, and Chandlers Ford.

In line with all other businesses around the country, they undertaken a full Health & Safety risk assessment and implemented a series of procedures and measures to help to protect our staff and visitors to the offices during the current crisis.

One of the procedures they were looking at introducing was checking and reordering the temperature of staff and visitors before entering the building.

Like many they started to use an IR temperature gun but found it impersonally and broke the 2m distance rule so started to look for alternatives.



Solution

Having discuss Langdowns requirement each of its offices required a different solution.

The EvolveFace 5T was the ideal solution because it could grow to meet Langdowns future needs.



Chandlers Ford office - This is the main head office with many staff and visitors. It was decided that for now all they wanted was to check the visitors and staff before they entered the building but in future it may be used to control the door leading into reception.

Andover - This is a satellite office with very few staff and visitors, and it was decided that the EvolveFace 5T should be located on the reception desk.



Basingstoke - This is another busy office. But due to site location it could not be mounted on a wall or reception desk so was mounted on a tripod stand.
